Other Things You Can Do

- Work closely with your local DV programs and state DV coalitions to bring education and training about domestic violence, sexual assault and elder abuse to your community.
- Connect with other faith-based people working to end abuse.
- Communicate with secular DV programs to better address the specific needs of your congregation
- Organize opportunities for DV programs to visit your congregation and provide trainings or workshops
- Raise awareness with events such as memorial vigils, "friendraisers," and used cell phone drives
- Provide meals, babysitting & free space for groups for the local shelter
- Provide rides to houses of worship for families in the shelter
- Provide sacred reading materials, etc. for shelters
